### ANNUAL REPORT 2025-26

#### **Beginning of the academic session (2025-2026)**

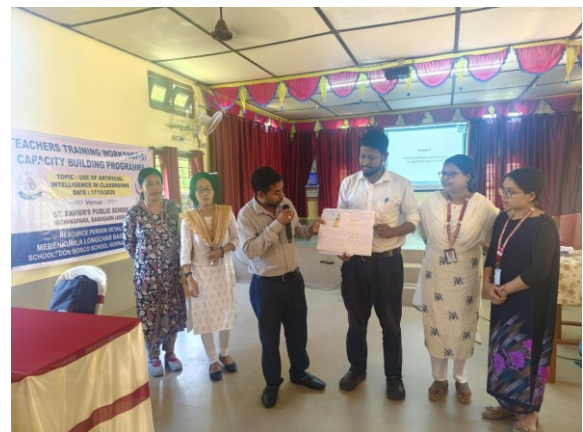
### **Report on National Teachers’ Conference Participation**
